Safety Procedures

We recognize that while how you do things have drastically changed, business has not stopped and the need for entrepreneurship is greater now than it ever was before. Safety in our Incubator

If you are experiencing **any** Covid-19 related symptoms, for the safety of all LaunchGSU members, please do NOT come to LaunchGSU. All members will be asked to complete a one-minute health screening upon entry via cell phone.

If you find out you have or have been exposed to Covid-19 after spending time at LaunchGSU, please notify Ms. Bracey ASAP at 678-571-7378

Six feet of spacing between students has been created by eliminating seating, marking off areas and configuring furniture to allow social distancing. LaunchGSU density is being reduced to a maximum capacity of 20 students. Face coverings are strongly suggested to be worn while inside LaunchGSU.

Hours of Operation

LaunchGSU hours of operation are being temporarily modified to DAILY 8am – 8pm.

Face Coverings

Everyone is encouraged to wear a mask or face covering while inside campus facilities. The system continues to work closely with the Georgia Department of Public Health to prioritize the health and safety of our campus communities. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends that everyone — whether vaccinated or not — wear face coverings while on our campuses.

Fully vaccinated individuals can resume campus classes, work and other activities without physically distancing. Unvaccinated individuals are strongly encouraged to continue socially distancing from others when possible.

Cleaning & Sanitation

Cleaning and sanitation are incredibly important while at LaunchGSU. Members will be required to immediately wash your hands in the restroom before entering LaunchGSU.

Members will be required to wipe down their workspace before AND after each work session. Safety is everyone's responsibility going forward.

Eating is currently permitted at LaunchGSU. We just ask that everyone practice extreme cleanliness. The Keurig and microwave will be available, but users must wipe it down after every use. Food will be removed from the refrigerator daily as overnight storage of food is no longer permitted.

Computer Usage

Members will be responsible for wiping down the work-station at the beginning and end of each work session.

Meetings

Meetings will be allowed at LaunchGSU during Fall 2021. We ask that students practice extreme cleanliness and wipe the tables down before and after a meeting.
